ORDER AUTHORIZING SALE OF HALLS MEMORY GARDEN CEMETERY
AND PROPERTY OF HALLS MEMORY GARDEN, INC. FREE AND
CLEAR OF LIENS AND INTEREST

This cause came on for hearing on the November 21, 2007 before the Honorable John F. Weaver. Upon motion of Dean B. Farmer, the Successor Receiver, to sell the Halls Memory Garden Cemetery and the real property of Halls Memory Garden, Inc. free and clear of liens and interest. It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that this sale is authorized as follows:

The Successor Receiver is authorized to sell the real property and cemetery operation free and clear of liens and interest with those interests to attach to proceeds to the extent as may be determined by this Court.
